

Responsible Minerals Sourcing Policy of Mirai Casting Holdings

Mirai Casting Holdings, Ltd. is committed to responsible sourcing practices to avoid procuring parts and materials containing conflict minerals (tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold) and other minerals such as cobalt that may be associated with the financing of armed groups, human rights abuses including child labor, corruption, or environmental degradation in conflict-affected and high-risk areas.

Specifically, we strive to deepen our understanding of the social issues faced by mineral-producing countries and the role expected of businesses in addressing these challenges. We respect the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas and will continue to conduct supply chain investigations and related initiatives based on its principles.

In addition, we request our procurement partners to utilize internationally recognized tools provided by the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI), such as the Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT) and the Extended Minerals Reporting Template (EMRT), to investigate supply chain information, including the identification of mineral countries of origin and smelters/refiners.

At the same time, we will encourage sourcing from smelters and refiners that conform to the Responsible Minerals Assurance Process (RMAP).
